ISC shines light on rolling blackouts

Information Support Concepts, Inc., Arlington, Texas. The unexpected leap in temperatures across the state of Texas, reaching the 100 degree mark earlier than expected, caused a lack of generating capacity that led to the phenomenon called rolling blackouts.

In an age of massive computer dependency, power outages can cause havoc, not to mention how various emergency facilities are affected. This type of crisis underlines the need for efficient Uninterruptible Power Supply (UPS) systems. The system should not only provide run time for the short outages until the power returns to normal, but they should also allow critical systems to shut down gracefully.

Information Support Concepts (ISC) offers a UPS line that addresses this type of crisis. They can be programmed to gracefully shut down critical servers in the event of a power outage. In addition, if it appears that the power outage will outlast your normal battery back-up time, the administrator can contact the UPS via the network and instruct a graceful shutdown. These actions are accomplished via the Sentry II software that is standard with the ISC Minuteman UPS. With this software, as long as you connect the UPS to your server through the available RS232 port you can avoid complications such as data loss.
